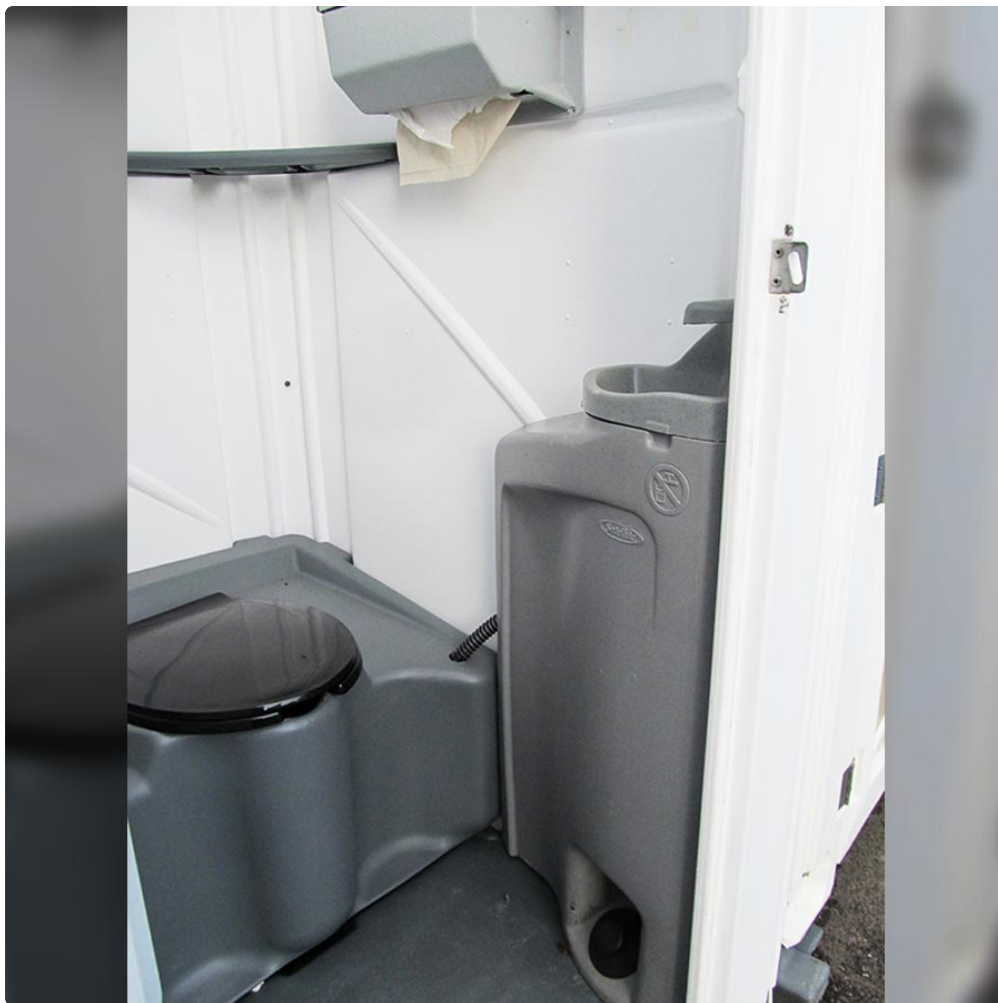
The role of the supplier matters as much as the equipment
