

Why Canoga Park Homeowners Need Dependable Garage Door Service

Other warning signs include a rattling garage door, shaking during operation, gaps around the weather seal, or a door that reverses unexpectedly. A door that works intermittently may still have a major mechanical or electrical defect, so avoid repeatedly cycling it while awaiting service.

Typical Costs for Springs, Panels, Openers, and Labor

Garage Door Repair Safety Guidelines for Los Angeles Homeowners

Garage door safety starts with treating the system as heavy mechanical equipment. Keep children and pets away from the door while it is moving, and never stand beneath a door that appears unsteady. Do not attempt to unwind or replace a torsion spring without qualified training and the correct tools. Spring tension can cause severe injury.

Test the automatic reverse feature regularly. Place an appropriate object in the door's path according to the opener manufacturer's instructions and confirm that the door reverses without undue force. Also test the automatic reverse sensor by checking that the door responds when the photo-eye beam is interrupted. Clean and align the sensors, but do not override them.

A garage door opener should be securely mounted, and its emergency release should be accessible. If the opener runs but the door does not move, stop using it until the connection and lifting system are examined. Lubricate only the components recommended by the manufacturer. Excess lubricant can collect dust and damage rollers or tracks.

Preventive maintenance may include tightening appropriate hardware, checking weather seals, inspecting cables and rollers, cleaning photo-eye lenses, and monitoring balance. Because heat, sun, and winter rain can affect seals, lubricants, painted panels, and exposed hardware in Los Angeles, regular inspections can spot damage promptly.
