

Before anything goes on the house

Nothing gets installed until the design is settled. That visit covers the roofline, the gables, the porch and anything else worth lighting. The consultation is free and it does not commit you to anything.

The design is drawn for your house

Every roofline is a little different, which is why one plan does not fit every home. A good design follows the architecture that is already there: the main roofline, the gables, the dormers, the porch. Businesses get the same treatment across storefronts, entries and building corners.

On the day

The crew does the whole thing. The channel goes up along the planned lines and is color matched to the house. Wiring gets tucked and routed out of sight, and the system gets tied into power and set up on the app. Before the crew leaves, somebody walks you through the app, so the first night is not a guessing game.

Business installs

For a business the steps are the same, though the building usually gives you more to work with. What changes is when the work happens. Most businesses would rather the crew work outside of open hours, so the work gets timed around business hours.

Getting the most out of the first visit

You do not have to do homework, but a few things make the visit better. Think about where you want light, not just where you want color. Think about whether this is mostly a holiday purchase or mostly an everyday one, because the answer changes the design. And look at your own house after dark once, because dark spots are obvious then and invisible at two in the afternoon.

The first few weeks

Most people spend the first week trying every color in the app. That is [EverCrest Lighting permanent lighting installation](#) part of it, and then a routine sets in. The routine is generally a single warm white that comes on at dusk, with the color saved for the days that call for it. The other thing to do in the first week is the schedule itself. Lighting you have to remember to turn on does not get used as much. Homeowners are not needed for most of it. The practical list is short: unlock the gate, move the cars, keep the dog in. Otherwise it is not your project.

After the install

After that, you pick your everyday setting and forget about it. The everyday setting usually ends up plain and warm, with color kept for the days that call for it. What is permanent outdoor lighting?

Permanent outdoor lighting is a fixed LED system installed along a building's roofline, eaves and architectural lines and left in place all year. The LEDs sit in a track that is color matched to the trim, and the system is controlled from a smartphone app. It replaces the seasonal strands that go up and come down each year.

Are the lights noticeable during the day?

The track is color matched to the trim or fascia and mounted tight along the edge of the roofline, so it is designed to stay discreet in daylight and read as part of the house rather than as decoration.

Does EverCrest Lighting install Christmas lights?

Yes. EverCrest Lighting installs Christmas and holiday lighting, and also installs permanent LED systems that handle holiday colors from an app. On traditional holiday lighting, EverCrest Lighting handles takedown at the end of the season and off season storage.
