Unique Causes and Root Attributes of Rig Truck Accidents in California

Rig truck accidents are unique because the trucking industry is heavily regulated by California and federal law. Common causes include driver fatigue, distracted driving, speeding, improper lane changes, brake failure, cargo shifting, and poor truck maintenance. Each cause may trigger liability under different legal theories. One critical fact from the "Large Truck Crash Causation Study" conducted by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in 2007 is that driver error is the critical reason for the majority of huge truck crashes. This study, [available here](#), showed that truck driver actions were the critical reason in 55 percent of crashes, while car driver actions were the critical reason in 41 percent of crashes.

Another unique attribute of big rig cases is the potential for multiple defendants. One case can involve the truck driver, the trucking company, the cargo loading company, a parts manufacturer, and even a government entity responsible for road maintenance. The Legal Landscape of Truck Accident Cases Under California Law

Truck accident cases in California are governed by state negligence law, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, and local court rules. California follows the legal rule of pure comparative fault, which means that even if you are partially at fault for the accident, you can still recover compensation. However, your total damages will be reduced by your percentage of fault. This is why it is vital to work with a lawyer who can challenge any suggestion that you caused the truck accident. The law also imposes a two-year statute of limitations for personal injury claims. In wrongful death cases, the family has two years from the date of death to file a claim. Do not wait too long because if the deadline passes, there is a fatal danger of losing your right to seek compensation forever.

One of the most important legal concepts in big rig cases is vicarious liability. A trucking company is generally liable for the negligent acts of its truck driver when the driver is acting within the scope of employment. This means that victims can demand compensation from the company, which often has far more money than the driver. The law group you choose must know how to prove a claim against the carrier, how to obtain driver logs, electronic logging device data, and maintenance records, and how to negotiate with defense lawyers. Steps to Take After a Big Rig Truck Accident: A Definitive Guide

What you do immediately after a rig truck accident can affect your legal claim. The following checklist outlines the most important actions to take. Some of these points are common sense while others may surprise you.

1. Call 911 and request police and emergency medical assistance.
2. Move to a safe location if it is possible to do so without worsening your injuries.
3. Exchange basic information personal information with the truck driver and other witnesses, but do not discuss liability.
4. Take photographs and video of the big rig truck, your car, skid marks, traffic lights, road conditions, and your visible injuries.
5. Seek medical care immediately, even if you feel only minor pain, because serious injuries can be hidden.
6. Preserve your clothing, phone records, and any damaged personal property on the accident scene.
7. Do not give a recorded statement to the trucking company's insurance adjuster.
8. Do not sign any release or settlement form without consulting an attorney.
9. Report the collision to your own car insurance company, but remind them that fault has not been determined.
10. Contact a truck accident lawyer at Eisenberg Law Group PC as soon as possible.
11. Keep a daily journal of your pain, mental anguish, and the ways your injuries affect your family and loved ones.
12. Let your lawyer manage all communication with the trucking company, the police investigation, and the legal process.

Compensation and Damages Available for Truck Accident Victims

The damages in a big rig truck accident case can be divided into three main categories: economic damages, non-economic damages, and punitive damages. Economic damages include past and future medical expenses including hospital visits, surgeries, rehabilitation, and durable medical equipment. They also include lost wages, loss of earning capacity, and household services like housekeeping or home health care. Non-economic damages include physical pain, emotional distress, loss of enjoyment of life, and loss of consortium for spouses and family members. Punitive damages are awarded in rare cases where the trucking company acted with extreme disregard for safety, such as forcing drivers to falsify logbooks or operating a truck with failed brakes.

The chart below provides a broad overview of typical damage categories in California truck accident claims. The actual amount of compensation depends on the severity of the accident, the clarity of liability, the quality of the

legal representation, and the venue in which the case is filed.

Comparative Risks and Dangers of Handling a Rig Accident Claim Without a Lawyer

There are many risks involved in trying to negotiate your own truck accident claim. Insurance adjusters are trained to protect their employers, not to help car accident victims. They will look for reasons to deny the claim, undermine your credibility, or pressure you into accepting a lowball offer. If you have suffered a serious injury, there is a fatal danger of accidentally making a statement that excuses the truck driver’s negligence. Even something as simple as saying “I didn’t see the truck” can be used to shift liability onto you. Another common risk is failing to understand the difference between economic loss and the long-term need for medical care. A quick settlement may not cover your future care needs, especially if you suffer a lingering soft tissue injury or traumatic brain injury.

Another risk is missing the two-year deadline. If you do not file a lawsuit before the statute of limitations expires, your claim will be permanently barred. The same deadline applies to a family member who has lost a loved one in a wrongful death truck accident. This is a strict legal rule with almost no exceptions. Hiring an attorney early ensures that all paperwork is filed correctly and on time. Our legal team at Eisenberg Law Group PC always tells clients not to handle these cases alone. How much does a big rig accident lawyer charge?

Most truck accident lawyers, including Eisenberg Law Group PC, work on a contingency fee basis. That means the attorneys are not paid out of pocket by the client. Instead, the law group receives a percentage of the settlement or jury verdict at the end of the case. If there is no recovery, the lawyer generally receives no fee. This pricing structure gives every injured person access to justice and motivated legal work.

Will my case go to trial?

The vast majority of truck accident cases are resolved through out-of-court settlement. However, a good law group must be fully prepared to go to trial. The defendant's willingness to offer a fair settlement often depends on whether they believe the plaintiff's attorney has trial experience. You should never sign anything immediately. The first offer is usually far lower than the true value of your claim. A quick settlement often does not account for long-term medical care, permanent disability, or emotional suffering. We recommend that you ask the lawyer to review any offer. Bojat Law Group has said in the past that early [eisenberg law group pc](#) settlement offers are often a ploy to close an investigation before the victim knows the full extent of their injuries. How long does a truck accident case take?

Insurance companies know that car accident victims without counsel rarely achieve maximum compensation.
