5	25	20%	80%
10	25	40%	60%
15	25	60%	40%

Note: As the game advances and tiles are gotten rid of, the possibility changes dynamically. If you successfully discover 5 gems without hitting a mine, the staying tiles contain a greater density of mines than when you started.

Mental Factors: Why We Feel "Lucky"

- **Verification Bias:** Players tend to remember the rounds where they cleared the board but forget the numerous rounds where they hit a mine on the 2nd click.
